

Non-Domestic Renewable Heat Incentive

New tariffs and tariff changes

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Factsheet



Subject to parliamentary approval, we anticipate a number of changes will be made to the Non-Domestic Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) in the next few months. This factsheet highlights what we believe to be the key changes to tariffs.

The following technologies will receive an increase to their tariffs

Technology	Capacity	Current tariff	New tariff	Available from
Ground source heat pumps	Small GSHP less than 100kWth	4.8p/kWh	Tier 1: 8.7p/kWh Tier 2: 2.6p/kWh (All capacities of GSHPs)	Available when the amendment regulations come into effect and for all GSHPs with a date of accreditation on or after 21 January 2013
	Large GSHP of 100kWth and above	3.5p/kWh		
Solar thermal collectors	Less than 200kWth	9.2p/kWh	10p/kWh	Available from date of commencement of amendment regulations and for all solar thermal collectors with a date of accreditation on or after 21 January 2013
Large biomass	1MWth and above	1p/kWh	2p/kWh	Available from date of commencement of amendment regulations and for all large biomass installations with a date of accreditation on or after 21 January 2013

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The following new tariffs will be introduced to the scheme

Technology	Capacity	New tariff	Available from
Air source heat pumps	All capacities	2.5p/kWh	Available for eligible installations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ first commissioned on or after 4 December 2013; and▪ application made on or after the date of commencement of amendment regulations.
New deep geothermal	All capacities	5p/kWh	Available for eligible installations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ first commissioned on or after 4 December 2013; and▪ application made on or after the date of commencement of amendment regulations.
New solid biomass CHP systems	All capacities	4.1p/kWh	Available for eligible installations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ first commissioned as part of a CHP system on or after 4 December 2013; and▪ application made on or after the date of commencement of amendment regulations; and▪ is certified under CHPQA.
Biogas	Medium biogas (200kWth and above up to 600kWth)	5.9p/kWh	Available for eligible installations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ first commissioned on or after 4 December 2013; and▪ application made on or after the date of commencement of amendment regulations.
	Large biogas (600kWth and above)	2.2p/kWh
